


Okinawa. International Passenger Flights at Naha Airport










Demand for MRO in the Asian region is expected to expand in the future.







Okinawa. Aircraft maintenance Hangar Capacity




Dock for wide body: 1 Wide body / Capability of painting Dock for narrow body: 3 Narrow body







First Stage [Present]

Foundation for Airframe Maintenance

Second Stage
