## 2. Disaster Prevention

Japan is prone to natural disasters.

These include earthquakes, heavy rains, typhoons, tsunamis, and other natural occurrences. It is best to prepare now the things that you will need to take with you so you are ready when disaster strikes. Also, be sure to have a family discussion about where you will evacuate to when there is an actual disaster.

### (3) Things to Prepare (Emergency Supplies)

- ① Food (ready-to-eat) and water
- ② Medicine (anything you take or use regularly)
- ③ Hygiene products (toothbrush, feminine hygiene items, diapers, etc.)
- ④ Valuables (money, ATM card, bankbook, personal seal, residence card, passport, etc.)
- ⑤ Flashlight
- ⑥ Mobile phone
- ⑦ Mobile phone charger and battery
- ⑧ Portable radio (battery-operated)
- ⑨ Spare batteries
- ⑩ Disinfectant & masks
- ⑪ Towels & tissues
- ⑫ Underwear & socks



### (4) Natural Disasters Information

When a natural disaster is likely to occur, information and announcements are provided according to five levels specifying what to do and what to be alert for.

	<b>Level 2</b>	Check warnings (be alert to rain, wind, waves, and other conditions) Check evacuation sites and ready items to take with you.
	<b>Level 1</b>	Check early advisories (start taking precautions early) Stay alert.



### 3. Living in Okinawa

#### Okinawa Prefecture's Location Within the Japanese Islands

Okinawa Prefecture is located southwest of the Japanese Archipelago.



#### Okinawa Prefecture's Many Islands

The main Okinawa Island (Honto) is the largest island in Okinawa Prefecture.

#### Climate of Okinawa

Okinawa has a subtropical maritime climate with high temperatures and high humidity. The temperature is moderate throughout the year, and it does not snow.

## (1) Who Needs to Register as a Resident?

Anyone who will live in Okinawa for three months or longer is required to register as a resident.

### ★ What can you do once you register?

- You can obtain a residence certificate.
- You can receive services from your municipality, such as garbage collection.
- The municipality will let you know what your My Number is.

## (2) Where Can You Register?

- You may register at the municipal office in the town or city where you live.
- There are different types of municipal offices in Okinawa:
  - ① City office (Shiyakusho)
  - ② Town office (Choyakuba)
  - ③ Village office (Sonyakuba)



## (3) Two Types of Resident Registration

#### (4) Marriage & Divorce Procedures

Type	When	Necessary documents ※Be sure to ask your local municipal office what documents you need to present.
Marriage	When you get married	① Marriage Registration Form ② Certificate of Legal Capacity to Contract Marriage (please check with your embassy or consulate) <b>(Note)</b> Be sure to check with your embassy or consulate whether your country of nationality recognizes Japan's marriage registration as documentation that two people are married.
Divorce	When you get divorced	① Divorce Registration Form <b>(Note)</b> Be sure to check with your embassy or consulate whether your country of nationality recognizes Japan's divorce registration as documentation that two people are divorced.

#### (5) Procedure When a Family or Household Member Passes Away

Type	When	Necessary documents ※Be sure to ask your local municipal office what documents you need to present.
Death	Within 7 days of learning of the person's death	① Death Registration Form ② Death Certificate <b>(Note 1)</b> These documents are submitted to either: ① Municipal office where the deceased person lived ② Municipal office where the person submitting these documents lives <b>(Note 2)</b> Please return the person's residence card to the Immigration Services Agency

#### (6) Personal Seal (Inkan) Registration Procedure

Type	When	Necessary documents ※Be sure to ask your local municipal office what documents you need to present.
Personal seal registration	When you enter into an important contract, such as for buying (or selling) a house or car	① Personal seal (inkan) (the one that you use) ② Personal Seal Registration Application Form  <b>(Note 1)</b> These documents are submitted to the municipal office where you live. <b>(Note 2)</b> A registered personal seal is called a jitsuin (official seal). Please keep your jitsuin in a safe place, and make sure no one else uses it. <b>(Note 3)</b> Once you have completed procedures ① and ② above, you will receive a personal seal registration card. This card is very important. Make sure no one else uses your card. <b>(Note 4)</b> Bring your personal seal registration card with you when you want to obtain a personal seal registration certificate at your local municipal office.

## (7) My Number

Once you have completed the move-in procedures at your local municipal office, you will receive your My Number (individual 12-digit number) by mail.

- ① How to Dispose of Garbage
  - Separate your garbage into the different types (called “bunbetsu”)
  - Check the day, place, and time for disposing of garbage
  - Use garbage bags designated by your local municipal office

### ★Important Things to Remember

- ① Driving a Car
  - Never drive after drinking alcohol!
  - Always carry your driver's license.
  - Drive on the left side of the road.

Both drivers and passengers must wear seatbelts.
